

The Shepherd Speaks—Fr. Eli Canete

We celebrate today with gratitude and joy the solemnity of our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the universe, the King of Kings as we also close the liturgical year. Today, we turn our thoughts, our prayers, and our gaze to the Lord for richly providing us throughout this year graces and blessings.

In the words of St. Therese of Lisieux, she said, "EVERYTHING THAT WE ARE AND WHAT WE HAVE IS GRACE." TRULY, GOD IS GOOD ALL THE TIME AND ALL THE TIME, GOD IS GOOD.

The greatest gift that we receive from the Father is his SON Jesus Christ. Yes, we receive him in the Liturgy of the Word and in Holy Communion, we say Amen. St. Augustine said. "Be what you received."

If Jesus is the center of our lives, then, our thoughts, our words, our actions should be a Christian thought, word, and action. But when Jesus is lost in the center, something and someone will replace Jesus. It can be our fleeting pleasures, selfishness, greed and vices. Then harm and sin can damage our relationship with Jesus.

We are created in the image and likeness of God. We are destined to be with God in heaven. And Jesus has told us that He will prepare us a place and He will come back to us. "Do not be afraid, I will be with you until the end of time."

To Jesus, we can bring our hopes and joys, our blessings and pains, our misery and struggle. We can even bring to him the darkest times of our life and how He will give us hope like what He did to the good thief.

While others treat Jesus with disdain, rejection, and insult, if you are the Christ, the Messiah King, save yourself by coming down from the Cross. The thief who went astray in his life but now repents, clings to Jesus and beg HIM, "REMEMBER ME WHEN YOU COME INTO YOUR KINGDOM. AND JESUS PROMISES HIM, TODAY, YOU WILL BE WITH ME IN PARADISE."

IN THE KINGDOM OF JESUS, HE ONLY SPEAKS FORGIVENESS, MERCY, LOVE, CARE AND KINDNESS. WE DO NOT HEAR WORDS OF CONDEMNATION. HE DOES NOT EVEN SEE AND COUNT THE GRAVITY OF OUR SINS. HE SIMPLY EMBRACE US WHEN WE GO BACK TO HIM.

TODAY, WE CAN ALL THINK OF OUR HISTORY, OUR MISTAKES, OUR SINS, AND LOOK SINCERELY AND HONESTLY, "LORD, REMEMBER ME BECAUSE I WANT TO BE GOOD BUT I AM WEAK. HELP ME AND GIVE ME STENGTH. I AM A SINNER."

AND JESUS CAN REMEMBER US WHEN WE ARE TRULY SORRY, WHEN WE HUMBLE OURSELVES BEFORE JESUS. THE PROMISE OF JESUS TO THE THIEF GIVES US HOPE, A GREAT HOPE. IT TELLS US THAT THE GRACE OF GOD IS ALWAYS GREATER THAN OUR SINS.

LET US ASK JESUS TO REMEMBER US AND TO BRING US INTO HIS KINGDOM. LET US ASK THE LORD TO REMEMBER US IN FAITH, HOPE AND LOVE THAT BY HIS MERCY, WE WILL BE ABLE TO SHARE HIS GLORY IN PARADISE.

As we enter the Advent season, I invite you and your family to encounter Jesus in the sacrament of Confession. I invite you also to praying the rosary with your family. I invite you to Adoration. And I invite you more and more to the richness and bountiful blessings of the Holy Mass.

Let us choose to put more of Christ into Advent. Let us prepare our hearts so that we may be able to give to one another the best and most important gift of all, CHRIST! More of you Lord Jesus and less of me, Amen.
