

#### The Shepherd Speaks—Fr. Eli Canete

"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; you shall have no other gods before me" (Exodus 20: 1-2)

Today, I invite you to reflect on God's power in our lives to free and rescue us especially from the kind of slavery to sin. It is a slavery that happens whenever we are trapped in sinful habits that we cannot get out of.

The good news is that just as God rescued the Israelites from physical slavery, God wants to rescue us from spiritual slavery. The idea of being someone's slave is naturally abhorrent to us. No one wants to be owned by someone else.

This is the same attitude that we should have when it comes to slavery, to sin as well. No one wants to be under its power. No one wants to feel powerless in some area of their lives. As St. Paul has said, we were created to be free. And Jesus came for just this purpose: to set us free (Galatians 5:1)

Always remember that the Lord our God is kind and merciful. He is slow to anger and rich in compassion. But most people experience the world as cruel, harsh, mean, merciless and uncompassionate.

Why? God's ways are not man's ways and all too often the ways of man rule the world. Jesus is inviting us to change that. Jesus envisions a world that is lovingly directed and rescued by God's ways.

So, do you want to experience freedom from sinful habits that has some control over your life?

First, confess your sins to the Lord. Know and remember that wherever you are now in your journey, the loads and baggage of sins that you carry will always be forgiven. Come and find your way back to the Lord in Reconciliation. He is just waiting for you with compassion and love.

When the Lord meets you at the throne of His grace, He always sees the good in your heart. Know that you are not the sum and total of all your faults and sins, but you are the sum and total of God's boundless love and mercy.

Second, pray for the strength to resist. Trust that God sees your efforts and blesses them with His own power to help us say no when temptation rises up within us. We may never stop sinning. But the process of sanctification, which comes as we pray, confess our sins, and seek God's strength, can help us reduce our sins.

It makes sin lose its power over us and makes us stronger in our efforts to resist. Jesus believes that you are infinitely valuable. You are worth saving and redeeming. You are always and will remain a child of God, temple of the Holy Spirit.

Wherever you are now in your journey in life, you are called, you matter, you belong!

## **FORMED**



#### **Communion Under Both Kinds**

As per the Roman Catholic Diocese of Calgary, and at the discretion of the Pastor, the distribution of the Precious Blood may resume beginning the First Sunday of Lent (Feb 17 & 18) but this is not a requirement. Parishes will need to prepare and inform parishioners of the principles that need to be observed.

Our Extraordinary Ministers of Communion have met and they have all agreed that three critical elements are needed before we resume the distribution of the Precious Blood at St. James Church:

- 1. a program of information regarding all aspects of concern and education be conducted through the bulletin and Mass announcements
- 2. the parishioners have time to absorb and comment on this direction and express their feelings toward it
- 3. the ministry of Communion leaders have time to work with current members about this direction and have time to find additional ministers required for each Mass

When we receive Christ from either the host or the chalice, we are receiving the fullness of Jesus' body, blood, soul, and divinity. Receiving both species is not required to receive the fullness of the sacrament. Once the Precious Blood is available, parishioners who prefer to receive the Precious Body only can continue to do so.
