

The Shepherd Speaks—Fr. Eli Canete

" I have risen, and I am with you still, alleluia. You have laid your hand upon me, alleluia. Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, alleluia, alleluia." (Cf. Psalm 138,18. 5-6)

YOU ARE CALLED. YOU MATTER. YOU BELONG. Beginning this 2024, Bishop William McGrattan immediately started to rekindle the hearts and souls of the Parish Renewal Team Members. The path of renewal to Synodality continues. We gathered in different pastoral zone areas listening to the moving stories of witnesses that testified about the great works of the Holy Spirit in their lives.

The joy of the Gospel moves the story tellers to share how Jesus leads them to building up their families but also building up as well their faith-communities.

In their testimonies, it is very clear that the primary reason to entering the Diocesan Renewal which highlights 3 Pastoral Priorities, namely, Form Missionary Disciples of Christ, Be a Church of Encounter and Witness and Strengthen Family Life is to know more the love of our Lord.

This love that comes from the risen Christ impels us to open our hearts and be involved to become storytellers and instruments of God's boundless love and mercy in our community as well.

Everyone is called. Each one of us is summoned to start the task. It is a call for all of us to a deeper encounter with Christ and be involved in making our parish community more vibrant, to nurture, help and support each other live our baptismal life and mission. There will always be trials and challenges. But the good news is we are never alone. We have the community, and we have the risen Lord who will continue to walk with us.

Instead, we are expected to live a joyful and peaceful life, constantly experiencing the real presence of the Risen Lord in all the events of our lives.

What do I do with my old glasses and hearing aids? We now have a box for these used items. Please look for the box "Lions Recycle for Sight" box now located in the parish hall. All donated items are refurbished, sanitized and packaged right here in Calgary! Packaged items are then sent with medical mission teams such as *Doctors Without Borders* to help those in developing countries who would normally not have access to vision and medical care. Simply place used glasses, sunglasses and hearing aids in the box.

Together in Action 2024 Goal \$36,218

This year's theme is inspired by Philippians 4:19: "God will fully satisfy every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus." This scripture encourages us to trust in God's abundant provision and share this abundance with others through service and love. Our diocesan goal is the same as last year: \$2 million. Nearly 50% of the proceeds will go to caring for our retired priests, hospital chaplaincy, and pastoral care. Approximately 10% will support diocesan missions, Mission Council and Elizabeth House. Another 15% will help organizations, such

as CCCB (Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops), Calgary Catholic Immigration Society, and the Canadian Catholic Bioethics Institute. In addition, for the next three years, close to 30% of the

yearly proceeds will be used to support local or regional healing and reconciliation initiatives for residential school survivors, their families, and their communities. For more information, visit www.catholicyyc/TIA
