The Shepherd Speaks—Fr. Eli Canete

Starting this MAY 2024, I will be integrating the Diocesan Pastoral Priorities in my reflection- homilies. As Catholics in the Diocese of Calgary are called to Form Missionary Disciples in Christ, the first action word that guides and inspires every baptized Christian is to invite others to know Christ.

Who do you say that I am? This is one of the questions that Jesus asked His disciples when they were in Caesarea Philippi. Jesus, of course, knew who he was. He didn't need the disciples to tell Him. Being divine, He also already knew what the disciples thought.

Now, it was time for the disciples to claim the identity of Jesus for themselves. It was Simon Peter who answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God."

He is the Messiah whose love and mercy is boundless. He is the Living God whose heart as the Good Shepherd never ceases to reach out to us. He is the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus who reminds us that we are always on a journey of renewal with and in Christ.

In the here and now, in our moments of joy, love, sadness or despair, Jesus is always present. The light of Christ perpetually shines the path, and his flame of hope burns brightly and rekindles us in a relationship both with Christ and with one another.

In any area that we do, if we do it without love, we will not find meaning and happiness in what we do, in what we are called to. For the very heart and soul of our mission, even the mission of the disciples is love. Love is the very core of what we are called to become because God is love and we are children of a loving God.

Jesus says in the Gospel, "it was not you who chose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit that will remain, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give you. I am giving you these commands so that you may love one another.

Peter teaches us that God shows no partiality in His love and there are no boundaries to abiding in love. Moreover, John says that let us love one another because love is from God. Everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God for God is love.

In our road to do our mission in life, we will always meet different people. Let me share with you Mother Teresa's Anyway: "She said, people are often unreasonable, illogical, and self-centered, forgive them anyway. If you are kind, people may accuse you of selfish, ulterior motives, be kind anyway."

If you are successful, you will win with some false friends and some true enemies, succeed anyway. If you are honest and frank, people may cheat you, be honest and frank anyway. What you spend years building, someone could destroy overnight, build anyway. If you find serenity and happiness, they are maybe jealous, be happy anyway.

The good you do today, people will often forget tomorrow, do good anyway. Give the world the best you have, and it may never be enough, give the world the best you have got anyway. You see, in the final analysis, it is between you and your God. It was never between you and them anyway.

So, begin your mission now. Invite and bring someone to our parish to know more Christ, to love more Christ and to serve more Christ, Amen.
